SUBJECT: **Detroit Diesel Reprogramming Software 7.0**

ISSUE

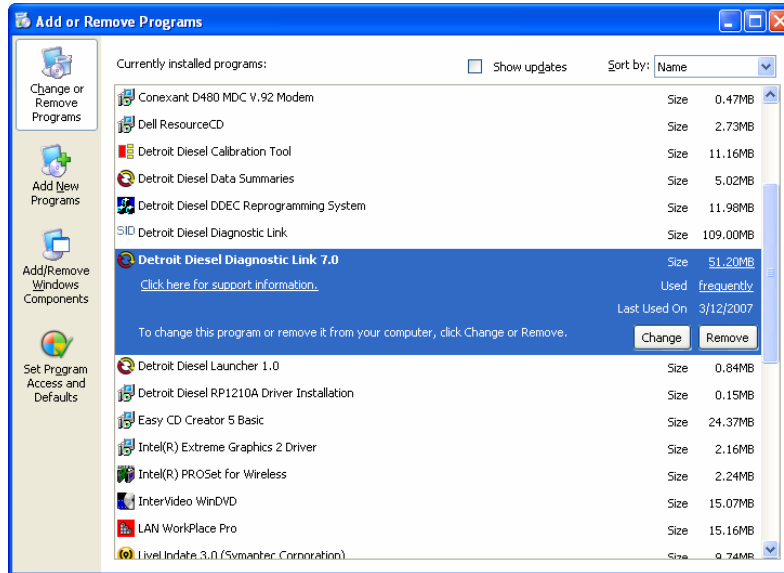
In February, a preliminary release of Detroit Diesel Diagnostic Link 7.0 was distributed to all service locations for a free 30-day trial period. The intent was to allow technicians the opportunity to become familiar with this new diagnostic program to service customers with EPA07 powered engines.

Detroit Diesel Reprogramming System (DDRS) 7.0 not only gives you the ability to program DDECVI engines, but also gives you access to EPA07 diagnostic features as well.

If you install the Detroit Diesel Reprogramming System (DDRS) software over the preliminary version of DDDL 7.0 on your Master Reprogramming Station laptop, you may experience communication errors and incompatibility issues with previously saved log files. You must uninstall your current version of DDDL 7.0 or DDRS 7.0 before installing the production DDRS 7.0 software.

The following instructions will take you through this process.

1. Click on **Start** and select **Control Panel**
2. Double-click on the **Add/Remove Programs** icon
3. Highlight the line that reads, *Detroit Diesel Diagnostic Link 7.0* and select **Remove**.
4. Install DDRS 7.0 from the CD provided



NOTE: Diagnostic Link 6.3 will continue to be required for servicing our DDEC II, III, IV and V engines and Pre-EPA07 MBE electronics. DDDL 6.3 will be included on the CD.

The production version of DDDL 7.0 is now available (P/N **J-DDDL-7.0CD**). Refer to 07 TS 19 for part number and ordering procedure.
