SUBJECT: **Engine Reprogramming Fees**

ISSUE

Detroit Diesel will be increasing the standard reprogramming fees effective Monday, November 26, 2007. Detroit Diesel has not increased fees for 10 years. Development costs, administrative costs, and server support have continued to rise. The increase is to help offset the program cost increases.

REQUIRED ACTION

Detroit Diesel is announcing the increase in standard reprogramming fees. The fees will be changed from the past dealer/distributor net of \$200 to a new dealer/distributor net of \$250. The suggested customer charge will also increase. Detroit Diesel will also recommend a \$100 increase in the customer charge; the new suggested customer reprogramming fee will be \$500.

NOTE: The reprogramming fee is waived when a customer is purchasing a horsepower uprate or a feature change. Example: If the customer purchases the parts to enable engine brakes, the reprogramming fee is waived with the purchase of parts.
